 - So that you may be restored to what God intended for your life
- 2. We teach the context and harmony of the Scriptures.

Acts 17:10-11 - ¹⁰And the brethren immediately sent away Paul and Silas by night unto Berea: who coming *thither* went into the synagogue of the Jews. ¹¹These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.

- 3. It is up to you.
 - This is a personal journey

Romans 14:5 - One man esteemeth one day above another: another esteemeth every day *alike*. Let every man be fully persuaded in his own mind.

• We must be reprovable and ready to repent

Habakkuk 2:1-3 - ¹I will stand upon my watch, and set me upon the tower, and will watch to see what he will say unto me, and what I shall answer when I am reproved. ²And the LORD answered me, and said, Write the vision, and make *it* plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it. ³For the vision *is* yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry.

4. Our beliefs are based on the King James Bible, not traditions of men.

Matthew 16:11-12 - ¹¹How is it that ye do not understand that I spake *it* not to you concerning bread, that ye should beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees? ¹²Then understood they how that he bade *them* not beware of the leaven of bread, but of the doctrine of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees.

John 14:15 - If ye love me, keep my commandments.

Proverbs 16:25 - There is a way that seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death.

2 Timothy 2:15 - Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

- 5. There is a battle for your life.
 - You are caught between two kingdoms
 - The battle is not against yourself or others

Ephesians 6:12 - For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.

- 6. Our journey to wholeness is on three levels—spirit, soul, and body
 - 1 Thessalonians 5:23 And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and *I pray God* your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.
 - John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- 7. We become separated from God when we become a servant of sin

Isaiah 59:2 - But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid *his* face from you, that he will not hear.

- 8. Our job:
 - Teach the Word of God because it is the divine influence on the human heart
 - Disciple you in who you are as a correct spiritual being
 - Encourage you to not get in a hurry to be healed because it can be instant or it can be a process

John 14:27 - Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

James 1:17 - Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.

Psalm 68:19 - Blessed be the Lord, who daily loadeth us with benefits, even the God of our salvation. Selah.

Pathways of Disease and Health

- 1. Pathways of disease and health are taught in Scripture
 - Divine health is a first principle of Scripture
 - Some teach healing passed away 2000 years ago
 - Some teach there is no connection between the human spirit and the physical body

Proverbs 17:22 - A merry heart doeth good *like* a medicine: but a broken spirit drieth the bones.

- 2. We may be without knowledge
 - God's people have gone into captivity because they have no knowledge and hell hath enlarged herself

Isaiah 5:13-14 - ¹³Therefore my people are gone into captivity, because *they have* no knowledge: and their honourable men *are* famished, and their multitude dried up with thirst. ¹⁴Therefore hell hath enlarged herself, and opened her mouth without measure: and their glory, and their multitude, and their pomp, and he that rejoiceth, shall descend into it.

- There are consequences to disobedience whether you are a believer or not
- Lack of knowledge brings destruction

Hosea 4:6 - My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children.

- 3. We may reject God and His ways and experience consequences
 - He has no choice but to withdraw until you are tired of following another god
 - If God allowed you to continue in your sin, He would be establishing evil in the Earth through you in the name of love.
- 4. Forgiveness of iniquities precedes the healing of disease

Psalm 103:3 - Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases;

• The first principle in the doctrines of Christ is repentance from dead works, not faith toward God

Hebrews 6:1 - Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward God.

• Obedience to the Word is more important than using the name of Jesus.

Psalm 138:2b - ...for thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name.

• Some people have disease resulting from their ancestor's sin issues.

Exodus 20:5 - Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God *am* a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth *generation* of them that hate me;

- 5. God wants us to prosper and be in health
 - 3 John 2 Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.
- 6. Disease follows relationship breakdown and involves separation on three levels
 - Separation from the Godhead
 - Separation from yourself
 - Separation from others
- 7. Healing begins with reconciliation with the Godhead, with yourself, and with others.

Matthew 22:37-40 – ³⁷Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. ³⁸This is the first and greatest commandment. ³⁹And the second *is* like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself. ⁴⁰On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets. (also see Luke 10:27)

- 2 Corinthians 7:1 Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.
- 8. God does not give us disease; disease is a curse.

Deuteronomy 28:15 - But it shall come to pass, if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe to do all his commandments and his statutes which I command thee this day; that all these curses shall come upon thee, and overtake thee:

- 9. You can appropriate what Jesus did at the cross so the Scriptures may be fulfilled.
 - 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

10. Disease is the product of a cause.

Proverbs 26:2 - As the bird by wandering, as the swallow by flying, so the curse causeless shall not come.

11. The Lord will keep His covenant with you if you are a doer of the Word.

Deuteronomy 7:15 - And the LORD will take away from thee all sickness, and will put none of the evil diseases of Egypt, which thou knowest, upon thee; but will lay them upon all *them* that hate thee.

12. There is grace and mercy in the law.

Deuteronomy 11:26-28 - ²⁶Behold, I set before you this day a blessing and a curse; ²⁷A blessing, if ye obey the commandments of the LORD your God, which I command you this day: ²⁸And a curse, if ye will not obey the commandments of the LORD your God, but turn aside out of the way which I command you this day, to go after other gods, which ye have not known.

13. You have a choice.

Deuteronomy 30:19 - I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, *that* I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live:

Father's Love

- 1. 80% of all incurable disease has its root in separation issues
 - Separation from God
 - Separation from self
 - Separation from others
- 2. The Bible tells us how to pray: to the Father in Jesus' name

Luke 11:2 - And he said unto them, When ye pray, say, Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth.

Jesus came to show us the Father

John 14:10 - Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.

• The Godhead includes the Father, Jesus the Son, and the Holy Ghost

Acts 17:29 - Forasmuch then as we are the offspring of God, we ought not to think that the Godhead is like unto gold, or silver, or stone, graven by art and man's device.

Romans 1:20 - For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, *even* his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse:

Colossians 2:9 - For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.

- God the Father is the Head
- 3. Many associate God the Father with the failure of an earthly father and He is guilty by association
 - Can cause a broken heart
 - Can cause disease
- 4. God says in Isaiah 61:4 that He would restore the desolation of many generations

Psalm 68:5 - A father of the fatherless, and a judge of the widows, is God in his holy habitation.

5. The Father's first ministry is to the fatherless and the widow

James 1:27 - Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world.

Three Connections with the Godhead

1. Petitioning the Father in the name of Jesus

Mark 11:23 - For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

Do not doubt

Hebrews 11:6 - But without faith *it is* impossible to please *him*: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and *that* he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

Come boldly

Luke 21:28 - And when these things begin to come to pass, then look up, and lift up your heads; for your redemption draweth nigh.

Hebrews 12:12 - Wherefore lift up the hands which hang down, and the feeble knees;

• Go to your Father in the name of Jesus

John 16:23-24 - ²³And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, Verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give *it* you. ²⁴Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.

• Jesus said, "The Father and I are One; " He represents the heart of the Father

John 16:25-27 - ²⁵These things have I spoken unto you in proverbs: but the time cometh, when I shall no more speak unto you in proverbs, but I shall shew you plainly of the Father. - ²⁶At that day ye shall ask in my name: and I say not unto you, that I will pray the Father for you: ²⁷For the Father himself loveth you, because ye have loved me, and have believed that I came out from God.

Jesus came to heal your broken heart

Isaiah 61:1 - The Spirit of the Lord GOD *is* upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to *them that are* bound;

John 14:9 - Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou *then*, Shew us the Father?

- 2. Worship of the Father and Son we do not worship the Holy Spirit
- 3. Fellowship with all three members: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit

Our Heavenly Father

1. Can be called "Daddy" or "Papa"

Romans 8:15 - For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

- 2. Has a physical appearance
- 3. Is called the Ancient of Days

Daniel 7:9-10 - 91 beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days did sit, whose garment was white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne was like the fiery flame, and his wheels as burning fire. 10A fiery stream issued and came forth from before him: thousand thousands ministered unto him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him: the judgment was set, and the books were opened.

Revelation 5:1 - And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals.

Revelation 5:2, 5-7 - ²And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof? ⁵And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof. ⁶And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth. ⁷And he came and took the book out of the right hand of him that sat upon the throne.

Jesus

Daniel 7:13 - I saw in the night visions, and, behold, *one* like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him.

Acts 2:22 - Ye men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know:

Acts 4:30 - By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus.

My Responsibility

1. I am my brother's keeper.

Galatians 6:1-2 - ¹Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted. ²Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ.

8Rs to Freedom

- 1. The 1st thing you must do before you can be free is Recognize you have a problem.
 - Isaiah 5:13 Therefore my people are gone into captivity, because *they have* no knowledge: and their honourable men *are* famished, and their multitude dried up with thirst.
 - What happens when you as a believer do not have knowledge or do not recognize what is right or wrong?
 - Isaiah 5:14 Therefore hell hath enlarged herself, and opened her mouth without measure: and their glory, and their multitude, and their pomp, and he that rejoiceth, shall descend into it.
 - God wants you to recognize the problem. This is so you won't go into captivity.
 - Hosea 4:6 My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children.
- 2. The **2nd** R to freedom after you Recognize is to take Responsibility.
 - Psalm 51:3 For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin is ever before me.
 - Take Responsibility rather than trying to justify it.
 - 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- 3. The 3rd R to freedom after you have Recognized and taken Responsibility is Repent.
 - Acts 3:19 Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord;
 - You can choose to Repent and get back on your journey.
 - Revelation 2:5a Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works...

- 4. The 4th R to freedom is to Renounce it.
 - To Renounce it is:
 - > to get away from it,
 - > to give it up,
 - > and to choose to separate yourself from it.
 - You cannot partake with devils and partake in the blessings of God.

1 Corinthians 10:21 - Ye cannot drink the cup of the Lord, and the cup of devils: ye cannot be partakers of the Lord's table, and of the table of devils.

5. The 5th R to freedom is to Remove the sin.

Ezekiel $18:31-32 - {}^{31}$ Cast away from you all your transgressions, whereby ye have transgressed; and make you a new heart and a new spirit: for why will ye die, O house of Israel? 32 For I have no pleasure in the death of him that dieth, saith the Lord GOD: wherefore turn *yourselves*, and live ye.

- 6. The 6th R to freedom is to Resist.
 - You cannot resist the devil unless you submit to God, and your ability to defeat satan is in direct proportion to your obedience to God.

James 4:7 - Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

7. The 7th R to freedom is Rejoice.

Isaiah 35:10 - And the ransomed of the LORD shall return, and come to Zion with songs and everlasting joy upon their heads: they shall obtain joy and gladness, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away.

8. The 8th R to freedom is to Restore.

Isaiah 42:22 - But this *is* a people robbed and spoiled; *they are* all of them snared in holes, and they are hid in prison houses: they are for a prey, and none delivereth; for a spoil, and none saith, Restore.

- King David was called a man after God's own heart.
- We see this great man of God Recognizing his sin all the way through his life and asking to be Restored.

Psalm 51:12-13 - 12Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation; and uphold me with thy free spirit. 13Then will I teach transgressors thy ways; and sinners shall be converted unto thee.

7 Steps to Sin

- 1. There are 7 steps to sin and sin doesn't just happen.
- 2. Many times we fall into sin because we assume we have already committed sin because we had the evil thought.
- 3. Sometimes it feels like sin has already happened.
- 4. The feelings and thoughts can feel so strong it can cause us to question whether we know God.
- 5. Temptation is not from God but temptation is from Satan's kingdom.

Mark 7:21-23 - ²¹For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, ²²Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness: ²³All these evil things come from within, and defile the man.

- 6. There is always a way of escape from temptation.
 - 1 Corinthians 10:13 There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God *is* faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear *it*.
- 7. God will not remove the temptation because He wants you to defeat the problem because it comes from within.
- 8. He has made a provision for you to deal with it.
- 9. You are responsible for your temptations and trials and you cannot make someone else responsible for your temptations.
- 10. God helps us walk through trials and temptations to bring us the crown of life.
 - James 1:12 Blessed *is* the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him.
- 11. God wants you to defeat temptation because in the day you don't, it becomes your sin.
- 12. It is a matter of obedience:
 - the Lord wants us to have intimate fellowship with Him
 - and that must be our priority.

- 13. The 7 Steps to Sin are found in James chapter 1.
 - James 1:14-15 ¹⁴But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed. ¹⁵Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death.
- 14. The first step to sin is temptation which is the thought of evil.
 - Hebrews 4:15 For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.
- 15. The second step to sin is being drawn away.
 - James 1:14 ¹⁴But every man is tempted, when he is <u>drawn away</u> of his own lust, and enticed.
- 16. The third step to sin is personal lust.
 - James 1:14 ¹⁴But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed.
- 17. The fourth step to sin is the enticement.
 - James 1:14 ¹⁴But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed.
- 18. The fifth step to sin is lust conceived.
 - James 1:14-15 ¹⁴But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed. ¹⁵Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death.
- 19. The sixth step to sin is the actual sin.
 - James 1:15a Then when lust hath conceived it bringeth forth sin...
- 20. When a man lusts after a woman:
 - to the degree that he imagines the act of committing adultery,
 - then he has already committed adultery,
 - even though it's in his heart and not yet in his physical body.
 - Matthew 5:28 But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.
- 21. The seventh step to sin is the consequence of the sin.
 - James 1:15b ...and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death.

- 22. Jesus knows what it is to be tempted and He understands.
- 23. He provided a way to escape the snare of the devil and his temptations so that you can overcome.



Godly Order

1. There is order in creation.

1 Corinthians 11:3 - But I would have you know, that the head of every man is Christ; and the head of the woman *is* the man; and the head of Christ *is* God.

2. We are created in His image.

Genesis 1:26 - And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

3. There is order in the Godhead:

God the Father thought it God the Word said it God the Holy Spirit did it

4. Women were created to follow men as an equal partner.

Genesis 2:23-24 - And Adam said, This *is* now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man. Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.

5. There is order in government in the Godhead.

John 5:19-20 - Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, Verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise. For the Father loveth the Son, and sheweth him all things that himself doeth: and he will shew him greater works than these, that ye may marvel.

6. Woman was created for the man.

1 Corinthians 11:8-9 - For the man is not of the woman; but the woman of the man. ⁹Neither was the man created for the woman; but the woman for the man.

Woman is the weaker vessel.

1 Peter 3:7 - Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with *them* according to knowledge, giving honour unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered.

In Christ, neither male nor female.

Galatians 3:28 - There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.

7. Your greatness as a man is how you serve.

Ephesians 5:25 - Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it;

John 10:10 - The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

Mark 10:43-45 - But so shall it not be among you: but whosoever will be great among you, shall be your minister: And whosoever of you will be the chiefest, shall be servant of all. For even the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many.

8. Ungodly order in the home is disobedience:

It brings confusion

It can be a curse of generational iniquity

Learning disabilities may result

Anger could be a consequence

There may be victimization

The enemy wants to destroy the family

9. It takes time to develop trust.

Women must have a safe place to be who they are.

Men need to have understanding and compassion toward their wives.

Women cannot be frustrated.

Women must remember they have a Father in Heaven.

Men must not accuse their wives as Adam did.

Genesis 3:12 - And the man said, The woman whom thou gavest *to be* with me, she gave me of the tree, and I did eat.

Women are responders.

Relationships must be based on friendship.

The man is ultimately responsible.

10. How can a man uncover a woman?

Making her responsible alone for any problem

Accusing her as the source of the problem

Leaving her in a place of fear

Having accusation toward her

Sin and Spirit World Realities

Three Heavens Found in the Scriptures

1. The first heaven – where we live, the physical creation of our planet

Revelation 21:1 - And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea.

2 The third heaven - where God lives

2 Corinthians 12:2 - I knew a man in Christ above fourteen years ago, (whether in the body, I cannot tell; or whether out of the body, I cannot tell: God knoweth;) such an one caught up to the third heaven.

3. The second heaven (dry place) - where disembodied invisible spirit beings live

Matthew 12:43 - When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest, and findeth none.

- They are evil spirit beings
- Ruled by Satan
- Your enemy
- Intelligent

Importance of Discerning of Spirits

- 1. One of the nine gifts of the Holy Spirit is discerning of spirits (1 Corinthians 12)
- 2. Two spiritual kingdoms are at work on the Earth today:
 - Body of Christ

1 Corinthians 12:27 - Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular.

Body of sin, led by Satan

Romans 6:6 - Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with *him*, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.

Ezekiel 28:14-18 - ¹⁴Thou *art* the anointed cherub that covereth; and I have set thee *so*: thou wast upon the holy mountain of God; thou hast walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire. ¹⁵Thou *wast* perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, till iniquity was found in thee. ¹⁶By the multitude of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with violence, and thou hast sinned: therefore I will cast thee as profane out

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of the mountain of God: and I will destroy thee, O covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire. ¹⁷Thine heart was lifted up because of thy beauty, thou hast corrupted thy wisdom by reason of thy brightness: I will cast thee to the ground, I will lay thee before kings, that they may behold thee. ¹⁸Thou hast defiled thy sanctuaries by the multitude of thine iniquities, by the iniquity of thy traffick; therefore will I bring forth a fire from the midst of thee, it shall devour thee, and I will bring thee to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all them that behold thee.

- 3. Satan's kingdom rebelled against God
 - Fell to the second heaven (dry place) in the environs of the Earth

Luke 10:18 - And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven.

Followed the angels, who rebelled first; Led by Lucifer

Isaiah 14:12-15 - ¹²How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! *how* art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations! ¹³For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: ¹⁴I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High. ¹⁵Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit.

A third of the angels followed

Revelation 12:4 - And his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven, and did cast them to the earth: and the dragon stood before the woman which was ready to be delivered, for to devour her child as soon as it was born.

• The old age ruled by angels came to an end

Genesis 1:2 - And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness *was* upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.

The Bible Records Two Floods

- 1. This planet was inhabited by beings before the Ice Age
 - They are now your enemies
 - They had physical bodies

Jeremiah 4:23-26 - ²³I beheld the earth, and, lo, *it was* without form, and void; and the heavens, and they *had* no light. ²⁴I beheld the mountains, and, lo, they trembled, and all the hills moved lightly. ²⁵I beheld, and, lo, *there was* no man, and all the birds of the heavens were fled. ²⁶I beheld, and, lo, the fruitful place *was* a wilderness, and all the cities thereof were broken down at the presence of the Lord, *and* by his fierce anger.

- 2. They rebelled; this rebellion occurred before Adam
 - Mountains trembling and hills moving indicates earthquakes and volcanoes
 - The whole planet earth went into a deep freeze (200 degrees below zero in one hour)
- 3. The freezing flood—Ice Age—is also referred to by the Apostle Peter

2 Peter 3:5-7 - ⁵For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water: ⁶Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished: ⁷But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men.

4. Everything on the earth that is evil began with the beings who rebelled in the world before Adam

Ecclesiastes 1:9-10 - ⁹The thing that hath been, it *is that* which shall be; and that which is done *is* that which shall be done: and *there is* no new *thing* under the sun. ¹⁰Is there *any* thing whereof it may be said, See, this *is* new? it hath been already of old time, which was before us.

5. Through the disobedience of one man (Adam), sin entered into mankind

Romans 5:12 – Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:

Genesis 2:16-17 - ¹⁶And the Lord God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat: ¹⁷But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.

- They ate of the fruit of the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil
- Their eyes were opened and they saw they were naked
- The thoughts Adam and Eve had were not their own

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Genesis 3:11 - And he said, Who told thee that thou *wast* naked? Hast thou eaten of the tree, whereof I commanded thee that thou shouldest not eat?

Genesis 3:5 - For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil.

- 6. Your enemy can train you in the law of sin, which you follow as if it were truth
 - Sin is not a state of being, but sin is a being in a state of existence by its fallen nature
 - Sin always involves thinking, speaking, or acting in a way that is contrary to how God thinks, speaks, or acts

The Source of Thoughts

Three sources:

1. Our own

Matthew 16:13-14 - ¹³When Jesus came into the coasts of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, saying, Whom do men say that I the Son of man am? ¹⁴And they said, Some *say that thou art* John the Baptist: some, Elias; and others, Jeremias, or one of the prophets.

2. Thoughts from God as a work of the Holy Spirit

Matthew 16:15-17 - ¹⁵He saith unto them, But whom say ye that I am? ¹⁶And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God. ¹⁷And Jesus answered and said unto him, Blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed *it* unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven.

3. Thoughts from Satan's kingdom

Matthew 16:21-23 - ²¹From that time forth began Jesus to shew unto his disciples, how that he must go unto Jerusalem, and suffer many things of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised again the third day. ²²Then Peter took him, and began to rebuke him, saying, Be it far from thee, Lord: this shall not be unto thee. ²³But he turned, and said unto Peter, Get thee behind me, Satan: thou art an offence unto me: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men.

You have the right to take your thoughts captive and kick that kingdom of Satan back to its dry place!

Mark 16:17-18 - ¹⁷And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; ¹⁸They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

Separation

- 1. There is an invisible kingdom
 - It needs you in order to manifest itself
 - It does not want to be discerned
 - It can speak through you like Satan did through Jesus' disciple Peter
- 2. Jesus defeated this kingdom on the cross

Revelation 21:7 - He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son.

3. We, as the church, are to demonstrate the manifold wisdom and counsel of God for the ages

Ephesians 3:10 - To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly *places* might be known by the church the manifold wisdom of God,

4. Paul identified our battle in Romans 7

Romans 7:15-16 - ¹⁵For that which I do I allow not: for what I would, that do I not; but what I hate, that do I. ¹⁶If then I do that which I would not, I consent unto the law that *it is* good.

Isaiah 5:20 - Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness; that put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter!

He separated himself from the evil manifesting through him.

Romans 7:17 - Now then it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me.

He said that by yielding, he allowed that evil kingdom to manifest.

1 John 1:9 - If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

He identified something that was not him.

Romans 7:18 - For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing: for to will is present with me; but *how* to perform that which is good I find not.

- 5. The word *flesh* in the Greek can mean:
 - Your body
 - The chicken you ate for dinner
 - Satan's kingdom

- 6. There is nothing good in Satan's kingdom
 - There is not 'good' evil and 'bad' evil
 - Satan will appear as an angel of light
 - He always wanted to be like the Most High God

2 Corinthians 11:14 - And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.

Isaiah 14:14 - I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High.

7. Your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost; your body is not evil

Romans 7:18 - For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing: for to will is present with me; but *how* to perform that which is good I find not.

- 8. The *flesh* in Romans 7:18 is the spiritual evil that has joined you
- 9. Paul identifies two laws in our members
 - The law of sin
 - The law of God

Romans 7:19-21 - ¹⁹For the good that I would I do not: but the evil which I would not, that I do. ²⁰Now if I do that I would not, it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me. ²¹I find then a law, that, when I would do good, evil is present with me.

Romans 7:22-23 - ²²For I delight in the law of God after the inward man: ²³But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members.

- 10. You have two choices:
 - Follow the Word of God and be a servant of God
 - Follow the law of sin and be a captive to Satan

Romans 8:1 - *There is* therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

11. God is not going to bless unrepentant rebels; He never has and He never will

Psalm 68:18 - Thou hast ascended on high, thou hast led captivity captive: thou hast received gifts for men; yea, *for* the rebellious also, that the LORD God might dwell *among them.*

12. Sin is not a psychological defect

Ephesians 6:12 - For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.

Victory Over the Law of Sin

- 1. Learn to separate yourself and others from what is not you or them
- 2. Stand against the wiles of the devil

Ephesians 6:11 - Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

- 3. Understand the battleground
 - Thought does not exist apart from the intellect of a rational, thinking being
 - Thought exists as an extension of an intelligent being with an intellectual thought process
 - Sin is not just something floating through mankind as a thought that tempts us
 - Our battle is not with flesh and blood but is with something within us called sin that lives inside of us

Ephesians 6:12 - For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.

- 4. When we allow sin to manifest through us, it becomes our sin
- 5. Four tiers of Satan's kingdom:
 - Principalities
 - Powers
 - Rulers of the darkness of this world
 - Spiritual wickedness in high places
- 6. Generational inherited iniquities are also known as the old man, the flesh, and the carnal nature
- 7. Your physical body does not make you sin
 - Thought is spiritual
 - Your body is physical
- 8. We are to cleanse ourselves of what is not of God

2 Corinthians 7:1 - Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.

Understanding Iniquity

1. Iniquity is part of the body of sin in your generations

Psalm 103:2-3 - ²Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: ³Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases;

2. Iniquities are the unrighteous thought and behavior patterns in yourself, your parents, and your grandparents

Psalm 51:5 - Behold, I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me.

- David inherited sexual immorality and an unclean perverse spirit
- Abraham had a lying spirit and a spirit of fear; this was also in his son Isaac
- Rebecca told Jacob to lie
- Jacob's sons also lied, saying Joseph had been killed
- 3. The iniquities of the fathers are transferred to the third and fourth generation

Exodus 20:5b - ... for I the LORD thy God *am* a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth *generation* of them that hate me;


4. A sign of maturity is being able to discern both good and evil

Hebrews 5:14 - But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, *even* those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

Romans 6:13 - Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God.

Pathways of Thought

- 1. Some thoughts come from Satan's kingdom to:
 - Tempt you
 - Speak to you
 - Try to control you
 - Form its personality as part of your personality



2. You are a triune being: spirit, soul, body

1 Thessalonians 5:23 - And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and *I pray God* your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

- 3. When Jesus died:
 - His spirit left His body
 - He went into Hell and preached to the spirits who were disobedient in the days of Noah

1 Peter 3:18-20 - ¹⁸For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit: ¹⁹By which also he went and preached unto the spirits in prison; ²⁰Which sometime were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water.

- His spirit entered back into His body and God raised Him from the dead
- 4. We are looking at three types of brainwaves: alpha, beta, and theta
 - They operate in the realm of your physiological brain
 - All three brainwaves facilitate images, thought, and how you process thought
 - Your soul is the bridge between the spirit world and the physical world

Beta Brainwaves

- 1. Beta brainwaves allow your brain to pick up images of sight and sound through an electrochemical process
- 2. In short-term memory, your brain records your experiences from the physical world
- 3. A renewing of the mind must occur:
 - Meditate on the Word of God
 - Protein synthesis occurs
 - The law of God becomes part of your personality (soul); it becomes flesh to your flesh
- 4. The law of sin can also be reinforced:
 - By a being which is sin by its fallen nature
 - Because your mind has not been renewed

Theta Brainwaves

- 1. The pathway of impressions, thoughts, and pictures that connect your brain to your spirit man
- 2. Provide a conscience to speak to you so you can hear the voice of the Holy Spirit:
 - Bearing witness to truth
 - Convicting you
- 3. An evil spirit can speak to your spirit. You perceive its thoughts at the soul level through theta brainwave activity

Your Thoughts Matter

- 1. Humans think first, and then we feel
- 2. Humans only know what they have been taught
 - 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- 3. We have been influenced by counterfeit thinking
- 4. God wants to eliminate the things that are not of Him
- 5. God wants to teach you how to think and how to live

Alpha Brainwaves

Give you the ability to have cognitive, deductive reasoning and record all the things that you've perceived externally and internally

The Enemy's Work

- 1. At the spirit level, the wrong thinking triggers the body to break down into disease
- 2. The enemy controls the activity of your hypothalamus by giving you a thought, to which your body responds
- 3. Your soul responds to theta or beta brainwave activity
- 4. Your soul is a bridge between your spirit and your body
- 5. You need to press on to maturity so you can discern both good and evil
 - Hebrews 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, *even* those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
 - There is a battle and it is not easy to be led by the Spirit of God
 - If these things have become part of your personality, then you are serving sin
 - God will not overtake you; He will assist you
 - Can you take spiritual inventory of your life without fear?

Disease Profiles

- 1. Disease management is not our goal. Disease prevention and eradication is our goal
- 2. God has given each of us a free will

Deuteronomy 28:1-2 - ¹And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe *and* to do all his commandments which I command thee this day, that the LORD thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth: ²And all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee, if you will hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God.

Deuteronomy 28:15 - But it shall come to pass, if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe to do all his commandments and his statutes which I command thee this day; that all these curses shall come upon thee, and overtake thee:

- 3. Fear can hold back the hand of God in your life
 - 2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.
 - Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.
- 4. You need a strong immune system

Proverbs 17:22 - A merry heart doeth good like a medicine: but a broken spirit dries the bones.

5. Both Old and New Testaments show diseases caused by evil spirits (Luke 13:11; Matt. 9:32-33)


Proverbs 26:2 - As the bird by wandering, as the swallow by flying, so the curse causeless shall not come.

Homeostasis

- 1. Limbic System:
 - Mind—body connection
 - Initiates activity of hypothalamus through thought
 - Integrates emotional responses with stored memories
 - Influences endocrine and autonomic nervous systems



Tracking Fear in the Brain




- 2. Hypothalamus Gland master gland of endocrine system
- 3. Endocrine System:
 - Connects with nervous system through hypothalamus
 - Maintains chemical balance
 - Glands secrete hormones
 - Pituitary Gland is the master
 - Glands control growth, development, mood, well-being, metabolism, reproductive function

Endocrine System




4. Fight or Flight:

- God's plan for us to respond to danger
- Prolonged cortisol release is a detriment to the immune system



When Cortisol is Oversecreted



5. Cortisol – necessary but harmful if released in excessive amounts

- Damages immune system by inhibiting the production of Interleukin 1 and macrophages
- Stops the recruiting of T cells
- Inhibits production of Interleukin 2 and reduces further recruiting of helper and suppressor T cells

Examples of Dis-ease

- 1. Multiple Chemical Sensitivities
 - Stands on two legs: fear and occultism
 - Self-pity ties it all together

Ephesians 5:26 - That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,

- 2. Infertility
- 3. Cancer
- 4. Hyper- and Hypo- dynamics of secretion
 - Hyperthyroidism (Graves' Disease) is the over-secretion of thyroxin
 - Hypothyroidism (Hashimoto's Disease) is the under-secretion of thyroxin.
 - Hypoglycemia is the result of a lowering of blood sugar.
- 5. Obsessive Compulsive Disorder (OCD), compulsive eating, bingeing and anorexia are the result of an under-secretion of serotonin.
- 6. Reduction of serotonin (levels)
 - Self-hatred slows metabolism
 - Insanity
- 7. Cell membrane semi-rigidity diseases
 - Asthma
 - Toxicity
- 8. Psychogenic
 - Fibromyalgia
- 9. Autoimmune Diseases body attacks the body; usually resulting from rejection by a father

Romans 6:12 - Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereo

Spiritual Blocks to Healing

Blocks are sin issues that may not have caused the disease, but can prevent healing if not dealt with.

- 1. Unforgiveness is the #1 block to healing
 - a. We are promised we will receive what we ask in faith:

Mark 11:22-24 And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

b. The next two verses are important but are often not quoted:

Mark 11:25-26 And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.

Matthew 6:14-15 For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

c. Our forgiveness is proportional to being obedient to forgive.

Matthew 5:44-48 But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you; That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust. For if ye love them which love you, what reward have ye? do not even the publicans the same? And if ye salute your brethren only, what do ye more than others? do not even the publicans so? Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.

Matthew 18:21-22 Then came Peter to him, and said, Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? till seven times? Jesus saith unto him, I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven.

d. Practice Separation – The sin operating in them is not them!

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e. The piercings may be deep, but Jesus was beaten and crucified without sin or crime, Pilate even said he found no fault in Him. On the cross He said, "Father forgive them, for they know not what they do."

John 20:23 Whose soever sins ye remit, they are remitted unto them; and whose soever sins ye retain, they are retained.

2. Ignorance / Lack of Knowledge

a. Ignorance is a form of knowledge. Those who are ignorant do not know they are ignorant.

Isaiah 5:13-14 Therefore my people are gone into captivity, because they have no knowledge: and their honourable men are famished, and their multitude dried up with thirst. Therefore hell hath enlarged herself, and opened her mouth without measure: and their glory, and their multitude, and their pomp, and he that rejoiceth, shall descend into it.

Proverbs 1:7 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction.

Proverbs 9:10 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding.

1 Corinthians 13:12 For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also I am known.

3. Personal and Family Sins – Iniquities

- a. Sin single act of failure
- b. Iniquity inherited genetic disease, or thought pattern. Some thought patterns are inherited without a genetic indicator.

Isaiah 59:1-2 Behold, the LORD'S hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear: But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear.

c. Hate – means we do not love, which means we fail to keep His commandments.

Exodus 20:5 and Deuteronomy 5:9 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me;

d. How do we get rid of this block?

Exodus 20:6 and Deuteronomy 5:9 And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me and keep my commandments.

Psalm 103:3 Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases;

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Nehemiah 9:2 And the seed of Israel separated themselves from all strangers, and stood and confessed their sins, and the iniquities of their fathers.

- 4. Looking to man rather than God
 - a. Be in Health is not against doctors or physicians, but they can only see what is happening to our body in the physical.

Jeremiah 17:5, 7 ⁵Thus saith the LORD; Cursed be the man that trusteth in man, and maketh flesh his arm, and whose heart departeth from the LORD. ⁷Blessed is the man that trusteth in the LORD, and whose hope the LORD is.

- b. In 2 Chronicles 16, King Asa died because he never sought the Lord.
- 5. Not being honest and transparent

James 5:16 Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

Proverbs 28:13 He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh them shall have mercy.

Galatians 6:1-2 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted. Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ.

6. Improper Care of the Body

1 Corinthians 6:19-20 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

Philippians 2:25-30 Yet I supposed it necessary to send to you Epaphroditus, my brother, and companion in labour, and fellowsoldier, but your messenger, and he that ministered to my wants. For he longed after you all, and was full of heaviness, because that ye had heard that he had been sick. For indeed he was sick nigh unto death: but God had mercy on him; and not on him only, but on me also, lest I should have sorrow upon sorrow. I sent him therefore the more carefully, that, when ye see him again, ye may rejoice, and that I may be the less sorrowful. Receive him therefore in the Lord with all gladness; and hold such in reputation: Because for the work of Christ he was nigh unto death, not regarding his life, to supply your lack of service toward me.

7. Not discerning the Lord's Body

1 Corinthians 11:27-30 Wherefore whosoever shall eat this bread, and drink this cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord. But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup. For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep.

- a. Three aspects to taking communion unworthily that could cause it to become a curse for us:
 - i. Taking the cup unworthily
 - ii. Taking while in strife with one another

1 John 3:14 We know that we have passed from death unto life, because we love the brethren. He that loveth not his brother abideth in death.

1 John 4:20 If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen?

1 Corinthians 10:16-17 The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ? For we being many are one bread, and one body: for we are all partakers of that one bread.

iii. Taking the bread while not believing God heals today

1 Peter 2:24 Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.

8. Not Resisting the Enemy

Isaiah 38:1-5 In those days was Hezekiah sick unto death. And Isaiah the prophet the son of Amoz came unto him, and said unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Set thine house in order: for thou shalt die, and not live. Then Hezekiah turned his face toward the wall, and prayed unto the LORD, And said, Remember now, O LORD, I beseech thee, how I have walked before thee in truth and with a perfect heart, and have done that which is good in thy sight. And Hezekiah wept sore. Then came the word of the LORD to Isaiah, saying, Go, and say to Hezekiah, Thus saith the LORD, the God of David thy father, I have heard thy prayer, I have seen thy tears: behold, I will add unto thy days fifteen years.

1 Peter 5:8-9 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour: Whom resist stedfast in the faith, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world.

James 4:7-8 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded.

Deuteronomy 30:19 I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live:

9. Rejecting Healing as part of the Covenant for Today

Isaiah 53:4 Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

1 Peter 2:24 Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.

Psalm 103:3 Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases;

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.

James 1:17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.

Mark 16:15-18 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

Mark 6:5-6 And he could there do no mighty work, save that he laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed them. And he marvelled because of their unbelief. And he went round about the villages, teaching.

10. Murmuring and Complaining

Numbers 12:1-15 And Miriam and Aaron spake against Moses because of the Ethiopian woman whom he had married: for he had married an Ethiopian woman. And they said, Hath the LORD indeed spoken only by Moses? hath he not spoken also by us? And the LORD heard it. (Now the man Moses was very meek, above all the men which were upon the face of the earth.) And the LORD spake suddenly unto Moses, and unto Aaron, and unto Miriam, Come out ye three unto the tabernacle of the congregation. And they three came out. And the LORD came down in the pillar of the cloud, and stood in the door of the tabernacle, and called Aaron and Miriam: and they both came forth. And he said, Hear now my words: If there be a prophet among you, I the LORD will make myself known unto him in a vision, and will speak unto him in a dream. My servant Moses is not so, who is faithful in all mine house. With him will I speak mouth to mouth, even apparently, and not in dark speeches; and the similitude of the LORD shall he behold: wherefore then were ye not afraid to speak against my servant Moses? And the anger of the LORD was kindled against them; and he departed. And the cloud departed from off the tabernacle; and, behold, Miriam became leprous, white as snow: and Aaron looked upon Miriam, and, behold, she was leprous. And Aaron said unto Moses, Alas, my lord, I beseech thee, lay not the sin upon us, wherein we have done foolishly, and wherein we have sinned. Let her not be as one dead, of whom the flesh is half consumed when he cometh out of his mother's womb. And Moses cried unto the LORD, saying, Heal her now, O God, I beseech thee. And the LORD said unto Moses, If her father had but spit in her face, should she not be ashamed seven days? let her be shut out from the camp seven days, and after that let her be received in again. And Miriam was shut out from the camp seven days: and the people journeyed not till Miriam was brought in again.

1 Corinthians 10:10-11 Neither murmur ye, as some of them also murmured, and were destroyed of the destroyer. Now all these things happened unto them for ensamples: and they are written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the world are come.

Philippians 2:14-15 Do all things without murmurings and disputings: That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world;

Self-Pity

- 1. Definition being a victim of events and deserving of condolences
 - Acts as an anesthesia
 - Acts like a mood-altering substance
 - Is highly addictive
- 2. Anything we put our affection on repeatedly can be addictive

Self-Pity:

- Takes a victim's role
- Does not deal with the present problem
- Is self-sustaining
- Always pays attention to itself
- Is self-soothing
- Manipulates others and punishes others
- Makes others feel guilty for not bending towards it
- Is a step away from anger
- Controls others
- Always has to place blame
- Always has a reason why it can't overcome sometimes blames itself
- Always retreats
- Always isolates
- Plays on your love
- Welcomes sickness so the focus will be on self
- Doesn't want true help
- Doesn't want to hear any voice other than its own
- Needs to be convinced and will not trust
- Always wants to be seen as small
- 3. Whenever there is a spirit with 'self' in front of it (self-righteousness, self-rejection, self-bitterness), idolatry is present
 - Says self is right
 - Says all other thinking (from God or others) is beneath it

Characteristics of Self-Pity:

- 1. Stubborn
 - 1 Samuel 15:23 For rebellion *is as* the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness *is as* iniquity and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the word of the Lord, he hath also rejected thee from *being* king.
- 2. One of the highest forms of pride
 - 1 Peter 5:5-6 ⁵Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all *of you* be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble. ⁶Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time:
- 3. Not founded in unworthiness, but in un-applauded pride

True vs. False Martyr

- 1. A true martyr:
 - Benefits the body of Christ
 - Lays down their life
 - Sacrifices with joy

Colossians 1:23-25 - ²³If ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, and *be* not moved away from the hope of the gospel, which ye have heard, *and* which was preached to every creature which is under heaven; whereof I Paul am made a minister; ²⁴Who now rejoice in my sufferings for you, and fill up that which is behind of the afflictions of Christ in my flesh for his body's sake, which is the church: ²⁵Whereof I am made a minister, according to the dispensation of God which is given to me for you, to fulfil the word of God;

2 Corinthians 11:23-28 - ²³Are they ministers of Christ? (I speak as a fool) I *am* more; in labours more abundant, in stripes above measure, in prisons more frequent, in deaths oft. ²⁴Of the Jews five times received I forty *stripes* save one. ²⁵Thrice was I beaten with rods, once was I stoned, thrice I suffered shipwreck, a night and a day I have been in the deep; ²⁶In journeyings often, *in* perils of waters, *in* perils of robbers, *in* perils by *mine own* countrymen, *in* perils by the heathen, *in* perils in the city, *in* perils in the wilderness, *in* perils in the sea, *in* perils among false brethren; ²⁷In weariness and painfulness, in watchings often, in hunger and thirst, in fastings often, in cold and nakedness. ²⁸Beside those things that are without, that which cometh upon me daily, the care of all the churches.

2. False martyrdom (self-pity) lays down life and makes sacrifices for sympathy

Defeating Self-Pity

1. Self-pity is defeated by gratefulness, thanksgiving, and joy!

James 1:2 - My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations;

1 Thessalonians 5:18 - In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.

Romans 1:21 - Because that, when they knew God, they glorified *him* not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

Philippians 4:6-9 - ⁶Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. ⁷And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. ⁸Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things. ⁹Those things, which ye have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, do: and the God of peace shall be with you.

Isaiah 61:1-3 - ¹The Spirit of the Lord God *is* upon me; because the Lord hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to *them that are* bound; ²To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn; ³To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, that he might be glorified.

- 2. You alone must take action to defeat it.
 - Self-pity is an enemy of choice
 - You will become what you think

2 Corinthians 10:5 - Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

Accusation

- 1. God does not want you to be afraid of evil, but He wants you to discern and recognize it.
 - 2 Corinthians 10:4-5 ⁴(For the weapons of our warfare *are* not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) ⁵Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- 2. The knowledge of sin (evil) came through the law.
 - Romans 3:20 Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the law *is* the knowledge of sin.
- 3. Accusing spirits can use truth as a weapon. Truth has to come with mercy.
 - Psalm 85:10 Mercy and truth are met together; righteousness and peace have kissed each other.
 - 2 Corinthians 3:6 Who also hath made us able ministers of the new testament; not of the letter, but of the spirit: for the letter killeth, but the spirit giveth life.
- 4. Accusing spirits always mix truth and error.
- 5. Accusing spirits build you up and then tear you down.
 - Matthew 10:16 Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.
- 6. Satan is relentless. He accuses the brethren before God day and night.
 - Revelation 12:10 And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.
- 7. There are three dimensions of accusation:
 - Against God
 - Against others
 - Against self
- 8. Self-Accusation: when we allow other's words and actions to tell us we are not accepted and don't belong.

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- 9. After being born again, Accusation can make you feel more unrighteous now than before you knew God.
- 10. If Satan's kingdom can't keep you from coming to God their next mission is to keep you from being fruitful as a believer.
- 11. There is no condemnation or guilt if you have confessed sin, turned away from it, and you are walking after the spirit.
 - Romans 8:1 *There is* therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
- 12. Characteristics of an Accusing Spirit:
 - Suspicion of others
 - Projecting fear/analyzing others' motives toward you
 - Continued bitterness toward others
 - Becoming bitter when exposed to another's failures
 - Mistrust due to failure of others in your life—you feel everyone will misuse you
 - Believing the worst about someone or something
 - Offending others or creating an offense
 - Being easily offended without a cause
 - Quickly judging based on misunderstandings
 - Exaggerating offenses and failures/building a case against another
 - Refusing fellowship even after they repent and change their ways
 - Focusing on the evil in a person and excluding all the good
- 13. People setting themselves against each other is a characteristic of the end times.
 - Matthew 24:7 For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places.
 - Matthew 24:10 And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another.
- 14. By allowing Accusing spirits to operate through you, there is a curse that comes.
 - Matthew 18:7 Woe unto the world because of offences! for it must needs be that offences come; but woe to that man by whom the offence cometh!
- 15. If you would normally point out someone's faults you can restore them instead.

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Galatians 6:1-2 - ¹Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted. ²Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ.

- 16. Operating in forgiveness by the blood of Jesus restores fellowship.
 - 1 John 1:7, 9 ⁷But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin. ⁹If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- 17. We are not to judge because it separates us from others.
 - Matthew 7:1-3 ¹Judge not, that ye be not judged. ²For with what judgment ye judge, ye shall be judged: and with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you again. ³And why beholdest thou the mote that is in thy brother's eye, but considerest not the beam that is in thine own eye?
- 18. Too often we judge others for sin issues we have.
 - Romans 2:1 Therefore thou art inexcusable, O man, whosoever thou art that judgest: for wherein thou judgest another, thou condemnest thyself; for thou that judgest doest the same things.
- 19. When someone wants to talk about another person don't listen!
 - Proverbs 10:18 He that hideth hatred with lying lips, and he that uttereth a slander, is a fool.
- 20. Slander is meant to damage a person's name and reputation. It also known as character assassination.
 - Proverbs 16:28 A froward man soweth strife: and a whisperer separateth chief friends.

Bitterness

Overview:

What is Bitterness?

How does the Stronghold of Bitterness work in the Enemy's kingdom;

Understand God's heart and mind toward Bitterness/Unforgiveness;

And how to Remove Bitterness from your life.

The #1 block to healing is Bitterness and Unforgiveness.

- The #1 block to healthy relationships can be Bitterness and Unforgiveness.
 Greek definition: acridity bitter and unpleasant smell or taste Bitterness comes from the Greek word that means poison
- Who is our real enemy?

Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

A Spirit of Bitterness needs a person in order to operate

• The evil spirit needs rest and wants to rest in your spiritual house

Luke 11:24 When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest; and finding none, he saith, I will return unto my house whence I came out.

The Strongman of Bitterness

Luke 11:21-22 When a strong man armed keepeth his palace, his goods are in peace: But when a stronger than he shall come upon him, and overcome him, he taketh from him all his armour wherein he trusted, and divideth his spoils.

There are seven spirits that undergird the Strong Man of Bitterness.

This is the list of the armor wherein the strong man trusts:

Bitterness

Unforgiveness

Resentment

Retaliation

Anger and Wrath

Hatred

Violence

Murder

Bitterness works with 3 dimensions of relationships:

- Bitterness towards God
- Bitterness towards self
- Bitterness towards others

Be honest with God and yourself to the degree that you can recognize these 7 in your life.

Consider what others have done to you (FORGIVE) and what you have done to others (REPENT to God and others.)

In order to recognize and defeat bitterness in your life, you MUST understand God's heart and mind toward bitterness.

a root of bitterness can spring up and trouble YOU

Hebrews 12:15 –Looking diligently lest any man fail of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up trouble you, and thereby many be defiled;

The Word of God gives a standard for how to deal with Unforgiveness

Matthew 18:23 Therefore is the kingdom of heaven likened unto a certain king, which would take account of his servants. 24 And when he had begun to reckon, one was brought unto him, which owed him ten thousand talents. 25 But forasmuch as he had not to pay, his lord commanded him to be sold, and his wife, and children, and all that he had, and payment to be made. 26 The servant therefore fell down, and worshipped him, saying, Lord, have patience with me, and I will pay thee all. 27 Then the lord of that servant was moved with compassion, and loosed him, and forgave him the debt. 28 But the same servant went out, and found one of his fellow servants, which owed him an hundred pence: and he laid hands on him, and took him by the throat, saying pay me that thou owest. 29 And his fellow servant fell down at his feet, and besought him, saying, Have patience with me, and I will pay thee all. 30 And he would not: but went and cast him into prison, till he should pay the debt. 31 So when his fellow servants saw what was done, they were very sorry, and came and told unto their lord all that was done. 32 The his lord, after that he had called him, said unto him, O thou wicked servant, I forgave thee all that debt, because thou desiredst me: 33 Shouldest not thou also have had compassion on thy fellow servant, even as I had pity on thee? 34 And his lord was wroth, and delivered him to the tormentors, till he should pay all that was due unto him. 35 so likewise shall my heavenly Father do also unto you, if ye from your hearts forgive not everyone his brother their trespasses.

Forgive us our debts as we forgive

Matthew 6:9-12 9 After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. 10 Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. 11 Give us this day our daily bread. 12 and forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors.

God can restore what was lost. As you forgive, He begins the restoration.

Joel 2:25 And I will restore to you the years that the locust hath eaten

There can be a link between Unforgiveness and unanswered prayer.

• Pray and forgive

Mark 11:24-26 24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive [them]. 25 And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. 26 But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.

Forgive them for they know not what they do

Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do.

• Remove it

Matthew 10:1 And when he had called unto [him] his twelve disciples, he gave them power [against] unclean spirits, to cast them out. And to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease.

Confess

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us [our] sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Envy and Jealousy

- 1. The Main goal of Envy & Jealousy is to take your eyes off God and put it on others.
- 2. It says what a person has is valuable and you appreciate who they are and what they have, but you hate them because they have it and you don't.
- 3. Envy and jealousy has you comparing yourself to someone else.
- 4. When you don't accept who you are and what God is doing in your life it keeps you from being who He created you to be.
- 5. Envy and jealousy is entwined with covetousness. To be "without covetousness" means to live without regard to gain.
 - Hebrews 13:5 *Let your* conversation *be* without covetousness; *and be* content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.
- 6. We need to take our eyes off others and know no man "after the flesh."
 - John 7:24 Judge not according to the appearance, but judge righteous judgment.
- 7. Envy and jealousy and covetousness doesn't want anyone else to have God's blessings.
- 8. The root for covetousness and envy/jealousy is not trusting God to take care of you.
- 9. We must learn to be content with what we have and trust God knows what we need.
 - Joshua 1:5 There shall not any man be able to stand before thee all the days of thy life: as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee: I will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.
 - Hebrews 13:6 So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me.
- 10. The bible says, "Godliness with contentment is great gain."
 - 1 Timothy 6:6 But godliness with contentment is great gain.

- 11. If you deal with covetousness and envy and jealousy, then God is able to bless you.
- 12. Fear will drive you into envy and jealousy and tell you things will be alright if you are like so-and-so (whoever you are comparing to).
- 13. There are 3 roots of envy and jealousy:
 - Not trusting God
 - Not believing He will take care of you
 - Not accepting yourself as He has accepted you
- 14. Covetousness is idolatry and envy and jealousy is rooted in idolatry.

Colossians 3:5 - Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry:

15. Jealousy is a spirit and it is found in the book of Numbers.

Numbers 5:14 - And the spirit of jealousy come upon him, and he be jealous of his wife, and she be defiled: or if the spirit of jealousy come upon him, and he be jealous of his wife, and she be not defiled:

- 16. A spirit of jealousy has rage behind it.
- 17. Paul indicated people could be delivered over to Satan because they were jealous for other things.
 - 1 Corinthians 5:5 To deliver such an one unto Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that the spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.
- 18. A person who is jealous is not interested in reconciliation.

Proverbs 6:34-35 - ³⁴For jealousy *is* the rage of a man: therefore he will not spare in the day of vengeance. ³⁵He will not regard any ransom; neither will he rest content, though thou givest many gifts.

19. A person who has a spirit of jealous is a very dangerous individual.

Proverbs 27:3-4 - ³A stone *is* heavy, and the sand weighty; but a fool's wrath *is* heavier than them both. ⁴Wrath *is* cruel, and anger is outrageous; but who *is* able to stand before envy?

20. Jealousy is a cruel spirit.

Song of Solomon 8:6 - Set me as a seal upon thine heart, as a seal upon thine arm: for love *is* strong as death; jealousy *is* cruel as the grave: the coals thereof *are* coals of fire, *which hath* a most vehement flame.

21. A person in envy and jealousy comes upon great devastation and it releases them to bitterness.

Exodus 15:23 - And when they came to Marah, they could not drink of the waters of Marah, for they *were* bitter: therefore the name of it was called Marah.

- 22. Evil jealousy destroys, but God's jealousy, even after your failures, receives your repentance
- 23. God desires your fellowship with Him and to be your best friend. He doesn't want to share you with devils.

Rejection

- 1. Rejection:
 - establishes your value by whether or not another human accepts you or not.
 - contradicts the bible because our value should be established by God.
 - There is no other being greater than God.

Romans 8:31 - What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us?

2. Rejection is a form of unbelief because it says you are not accepted of God.

Hebrews 4:9-11 - ⁹There remaineth therefore a rest to the people of God. ¹⁰For he that is entered into his rest, he also hath ceased from his own works, as God *did* from his. ¹¹Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief.

3. When you make man your god you are in idolatry and self-idolatry.

Exodus 20:3 - Thou shalt have no other gods before me.

4. God determined his plans for you before you were born.

Psalm 139:14-16 - ¹⁴I will praise thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made: marvellous are thy works; and that my soul knoweth right well. ¹⁵My substance was not hid from thee, when I was made in secret, and curiously wrought in the lowest parts of the earth. ¹⁶Thine eyes did see my substance, yet being unperfect; and in thy book all my members were written, which in continuance were fashioned, when as yet there was none of them.

5. Jesus was rejected of men.

Isaiah 53:3 - He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were *our* faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.

- 6. The Bible says that Jesus is acquainted with you griefs and sorrows and He is touched by the feelings of your infirmities. Hebrews 4:15 For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.
- 7. Rejection steals your joy and scars you.

Isaiah 54:1-2 - ¹Sing, O barren, thou *that* didst not bear; break forth into singing, and cry aloud, thou *that* didst not travail with child: for more *are* the children of the desolate than the children of the married wife, saith the LORD. ²Enlarge the place of thy tent, and let them stretch forth the curtains of thine habitations: spare not, lengthen thy cords, and strengthen thy stakes;

- 8. Rejection produces shame and guilt but God has given us freedom.
 - Isaiah 54:4 Fear not; for thou shalt not be ashamed: neither be thou confounded; for thou shalt not be put to shame: for thou shalt forget the shame of thy youth, and shalt not remember the reproach of thy widowhood any more.
- 9. If you fail, God has made a provision for you. Proverbs 24:16 For a just *man* falleth seven times, and riseth up again: but the wicked shall fall into mischief.
- 10. Abandonment and fear of abandonment are forms of rejection.
- 11. Rejection is:
 - a sense of being unwanted
 - and is the agony of desperately wanting people to love you
 - and being convinced they do not.
- 12. Defense Mechanisms:
 - 1. The first defense mechanism of rejection is withdrawal.
 - 2. The second defense mechanism for rejection is exploding with anger and hatred.
 - 3. The third defense mechanism is looking for a meaningful identity outside a true and complete relationship with God.
- 13. You need to accept God's love one and for all without doubt and unbelief to get freedom from rejection.
 - James 1:6 But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed.
- 14. The antidote for fear and rejection is believe God has given you power, love and a sound mind.
 - 2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.
- 15. The first prerequisite for becoming free of rejection is accepting God's love.

- 16. Father God has adopted us out of the world and instead of being abandoned, we are now accepted.
 - Romans 8:15 For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.
- 17. Don't let anything keep you from Father God's love.
 - Numbers 23:19 God *is* not a man, that he should lie; neither the son of man, that he should repent: hath he said, and shall he not do *it*? or hath he spoken, and shall he not make it good?
- 18. The greatest tragedy of your life would be not knowing the Father because all good things come down from Him in love.
 - James 1:17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.
- 19. The second and third prerequisites for becoming for becoming free from rejection:
 - loving yourself
 - loving your neighbor
 - Matthew 22:39 And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.
- 20. It is your choice if you will be a son or daughter of God and let Him take control of your future.
 - Romans 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.
- 21. You need a right spirit, a willingness to be taught by God, and you need to trust Him.
 - 1 Corinthians 2:9 But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.

<u>Occultism</u>

- 1. Occultism is based in philosophies and traditions of men as well as vain deceit and the rudiments of the world.
 - Colossians 2:4, 6-8 ⁴And this I say, lest any man should beguile you with enticing words. ⁶As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, *so* walk ye in him: ⁷Rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving. ⁸Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ.
- 2. Satan used to be called Lucifer the archangel. He was perfect from the day he was created until iniquity was found in his heart.
 - Ezekiel 28:15 Thou wast perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, till iniquity was found in thee.
 - Isaiah 14:13-14 ¹³For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: ¹⁴I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High.
- 3. In the bible he is called the god of this world.
 - 2 Corinthians 4:4 In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.
- 4. Satan's kingdom has an agenda to duplicate, replicate, or counterfeit the Godhead.
 - Deuteronomy 6:4 Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD:
- 5. Satan wants to counterfeit:
 - the will of the Father in the Earth
 - the Word of the Father which is Jesus
 - and the Holy Spirit

Ephesians 6:12 - For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.

- 6. Satan's kingdom gives false religions to take a mixture of truth and error and offer a form of godliness.
 - 2 Timothy 3:5 Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.
- 7. You may have something within you that wants to argue about a sermon or the Scriptures.
 - 2 Thessalonians 2:10-12 ¹⁰And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved. ¹¹And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie: ¹²That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.
- 8. Morals and Dogmas of Freemasonry by Albert Pike says that Jesus did not come in the flesh.
 - 1 John 4:3 And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that *spirit* of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.
- 9. Yoga and Christianized yoga practice a meditative state that has nothing to do with the Holy Spirit. Jesus gives the peace.
 - John 14:27 Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.
 - Isaiah 26:3 Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.
- 10. We can look to many things to modify our chemistry and give us peace such as:
 - sorcery
 - witchcraft
 - pharmakeia
 - drugs
 - spiritual bewitchment
 - meditative states
 - 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- 11. Meditation is thinking about things that are profitable, of good report, and fill you with the knowledge of God.
 - Philippians 4:8 Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things.

12. When a church does not understand blessings and curses they will open their hearts to anything.

Deuteronomy 28:2 - And all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God.

- 13. Satan uses the Word of God out of context; he perverts it and changes it.
 - 2 Timothy 2:15 Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.
- 14. In the Strong's Concordance (Greek) the word "python" is translated into English as "divination."

Acts 16:16-18 - ¹⁶And it came to pass, as we went to prayer, a certain damsel possessed with a spirit of divination met us, which brought her masters much gain by soothsaying: ¹⁷The same followed Paul and us, and cried, saying, These men are the servants of the most high God, which shew unto us the way of salvation. ¹⁸And this did she many days. But Paul, being grieved, turned and said to the spirit, I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her. And he came out the same hour.

- 15. Some Christian ministries teach Anima and Animus:
 - if you are a female, you can come in touch with your masculinity to be a better female
 - if you are a male you need to awaken your femininity to become a better man.
 - This contradicts Scripture which says:

Genesis 1:27 - So God created man in his *own* image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

- 16. Some have been involved in healing models to channel Jesus and call Jesus in to the picture:
 - This is hypnosis.
 - There is no evidence in the new testament of where Jesus ever appeared in the mind consciousness of any human.
 - Jesus appeared to Paul in a blinding light and His voice was heard externally by others.

Acts 26:13-15 - ¹³At midday, O king, I saw in the way a light from heaven, above the brightness of the sun, shining round about me and them which journeyed with me. ¹⁴And when we were all fallen to the earth, I heard a voice speaking unto me, and saying in the Hebrew tongue, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me? *it is* hard for thee to kick against the pricks. ¹⁵And I said, Who art thou, Lord? And he said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest.

- 17. Dreams and visions: Dreams are in the realm of the soul and spirit.
 - Visions: Jesus appeared to Paul in a vision which, in the Greek language, means an apparition.
 - That apparition would be a shimmering which was external.

Acts 18:9-10 - ⁹Then spake the Lord to Paul in the night by a vision, Be not afraid, but speak, and hold not thy peace: ¹⁰For I am with thee, and no man shall set on thee to hurt thee: for I have much people in this city. 18. The power of suggestion is key to hypnosis and you open yourself up to a suggestion:

- This includes statements such as: "Do you see Jesus over there" or "What is the Holy Spirit saying to you now?"
- You're going to assume the next thought that comes to your mind is the Holy Spirit.
- The next thought may not be the Holy Spirit.

1 John 4:1 - Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.

Galatians 1:8-9 - ⁸But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed. ⁹As we said before, so say I now again, If any *man* preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed.

- 18. If you have opened yourself up to any healing modality that didn't offer the truth of the Bible you have dipped into Occultism.
 - 2 Timothy 3:7-9 ⁷Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth. ⁸Now as Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, reprobate concerning the faith. ⁹But they shall proceed no further: for their folly shall be manifest unto all *men*, as theirs also was.

Unloving Spirits

- 1. You may be staring at yourself and don't like what you see, but the Bible says to love yourself.
- 2. Next to God, you ought to be your own best friend.
- 3. The Unloving spirit is:
 - a spirit that attaches itself to you
 - and makes you feel self-rejected, unclean, unworthy, no good
 - and like you don't measure up.
- 4. Evidences of the unloving:
 - Debate with yourself as to whether you belong here or not
 - Hate the way you look.
 - Think others hate you because you see it in their eyes
 - Spend your day in a world in which you never measure up
- 5. If someone doesn't like you it doesn't matter because God loves you and there is no one greater than Him.

Romans 3:4 - God forbid: yea, let God be true, but every man a liar; as it is written, That thou mightest be justified in thy sayings, and mightest overcome when thou art judged.

6. You are the apple of God's eye. The very focus of God's attention is right on you.

Deuteronomy 32:10 - He found him in a desert land, and in the waste howling wilderness; he led him about, he instructed him, he kept him as the apple of his eye.

Psalm 17:7-8 - ⁷Shew thy marvellous lovingkindness, O thou that savest by thy right hand them which put their trust *in thee* from those that rise up *against them*. ⁸Keep me as the apple of the eye, hide me under the shadow of thy wings,

7. If you have the unloving spirit, it is because you have been rejected, usually beginning right in your family.

- 8. But the Lord is going to help you despite those that rise up against you.
 - Hebrews 13:6 So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me.
 - 1 Peter 3:12 For the eyes of the Lord are over the righteous and his ears are open unto their prayers: but the face of the Lord is against them that do evil.
- 9. If you have an unloving spirit, it is hard to receive truth from others. You may take truth as victimization.
- 10. God will not be able to deal with you as children:
 - if you have an unloving spirit that has not been removed
 - because you won't receive the chastening of the Lord,
 - and you won't be able to receive the instruction of God correctly.
- 11. Discipline must be covered with love.
 - Psalm 68:18 Thou hast ascended on high, thou hast led captivity captive: thou hast received gifts for men; yea, for the rebellious also, that the LORD God might dwell among them
- 12. Inordinate affection is based on receiving and not giving.
- 13. When you don't have the ability to give and receive love without fear, you have an unloving spirit.
- 14. Are you able to feel good about yourself and still have things that are unrenewed in your life?
- 15. God loves you in your imperfectedness just as much as He is going to love you in your perfectedness:
 - His love for you is not based on your being totally perfected,
 - but His heart as a Father is to help you to be perfected.
- 16. The bible says that in your weakness He is made strong.
 - 2 Corinthians 12:9 And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

- 17. If you are in agreement with the unloving spirit:
 - You are not obeying God's Word, which means you are not loving Him.
 - You are in rebellion against God.
 - You have been commanded to love yourself and others.
 - John 14:15 If ye love me, keep my commandments
- 18. You need to take a stand against victimization, and if possible, live peaceably one with another.
 - Romans 12:18 If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men.
 - James 3:16 For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work.

Addictions

- 1. There are many kinds of addictions, including illegal drugs, gambling, alcohol, and even over-the-counter and prescription drugs.
- 2. Anything that rules you or controls you from within is an addiction.
 - Relationships based on inordinate affection
 - Relationships involving codependency
- 3. Satan can control you through your needs; Addictions rule you and control you and then become your master.

Galatians 3:1-3 - ¹O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you? ²This only would I learn of you, Received ye the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith? ³Are ye so foolish? having begun in the Spirit, are ye now made perfect by the flesh?

4. The spiritual root of addictions is the need to be loved.

Matthew 22:37-40 - ³⁷Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. ³⁸This is the first and great commandment. ³⁹And the second *is* like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. ⁴⁰On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.

- 5. The foundation for addictions is spiritual bewitchment; the remedy is to:
 - Understand and accept God's love.
 - Accept who you are in the new birth.
 - Love others.
- 6. Satan affects your chemistry through the mind-body connection.
 - He influences you through thoughts
 - Your hypothalamus responds
 - Pineal gland under-secretes serotonin
 - You can feel it

John 14:27 - Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

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- 7. The remedy is to remove the unloving spirit or take a serotonin-enhancing drug.
 - Chemically-altered states of consciousness violate creation
 - Your enemy can alter your chemistry
- 8. Spiritual bewitchment:
 - Says God doesn't love me, I don't love myself, and no one else loves me either
 - Opens the door to addictions, which manifest as works of the flesh

Galatians 5:19-21 - ¹⁹Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are *these*; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, ²⁰Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, ²¹Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told *you* in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.

- "Do" (verse 21) means to habitually practice as a way of life
- 9. Freedom comes from taking responsibility and being determined to repent.
 - Make a quality decision
 - Quit blaming others/the devil
 - Decide on a proper response to God
- 10. Works of the flesh are a poor substitute for your relationship with God.
- 11. Proper relationship with God, yourself, and others produces proper release of hormones and neurotransmitters so that you will feel good.
- 12. An altered state of consciousness does not give the ability to know right from wrong. It:
 - Changes your chemistry
 - Changes your consciousness
 - Hides your pain

1 John 4:18 - There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.

Fear

- 1. We get the knowledge of God by the Word of God.
 - Romans 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.
- 2. You will choose either fear or faith; without faith it is impossible to please God.
 - Hebrews 11:6 But without faith *it is* impossible to please *him*: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and *that* he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.
- 3. Faith is not work. Faith is simple.
 - Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.
- 4. Your hope must be stronger than your fears because faith always defeats fear.
 - Romans 12:3 For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think *of himself* more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.
- 5. When the spirit of fear:
 - comes and surrounds you
 - · with every thought and impression and every reality,
 - you can stand because you know who you are.
 - You know that God has not given you the spirit of fear.
 - 2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.
- 6. Job said that even if God would slay him, he would still trust Him.
 - Job 13:15 Though he slay me, yet will I trust in him: but I will maintain mine own ways before him.
- 7. Even though Job said this, he was still afraid he would lose his children.
 - Job 3:25 For the thing which I greatly feared is come upon me, and that which I was afraid of is come unto me.

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- 8. Satan is able to execute the object of fear if you give him the right.
- 9. You have to make a decision to either believe God or go into fear.
- 10. God intends you to face every circumstance, person, or problem in your life in faith and trust.
- 11. Your obedience to the Word mixed with your faith makes you free.
- 12. To defeat Satan with the Word of God, you have to believe it and make it a part of your life.
- 13. When you believe God and trust God, He will set things in motion to lead you out of captivity.
 - Matthew 6:33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.
- 14. Walking out in faith does not mean there is no more fear.
 - Ephesians 6:13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.
- 15. You are not to go to the far extremes of faith or fear because you have only been given a measure of faith.
 - Romans 12:3 For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think *of himself* more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.
- 16. If you want to defeat fear, you must build in a measure of time to receive. Fear drives, but faith leads!
- 17. Anxiety is part of fear and is always concerning a specific issue.
 - Philippians 4:6 Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.
 - 1 Peter 5:7 Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.
- 18. Stress is a modern English term for fear.
- 19. Stress can affect your physical heart and can also affect different parts of your body.
 - Luke 21:26 Men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth: for the powers of heaven shall be shaken.

Gifts and Baptism with the Holy Spirit

1. God has set in the church gifts, healings, and the working of miracles which are for today.

2 Corinthians 12:28 And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues.

a. The One Who did the healing through Jesus was God the Father.

Acts 2:22 Ye men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know

Acts 4:30-31 By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus. And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness.

2. In the book of Numbers, God took of the spirit that was upon Moses and put it on the 70 elders of Israel because Moses needed help.

Numbers 11:16-17 And the LORD said to Moses, Gather unto me seventy men of the elders of Israel, whom thou knowest to be the elders of the people, and officers over them; and bring them unto the tabernacle of the congregation, that they may stand there with thee. And I will come down and talk with thee there: and I will take of the Spirit which is upon thee, and will put it upon them; and they shall bear the burden of the people with thee, that thou bear it not thyself alone.

- a. Jesus took of the Spirit that was given to Him and released the Holy Spirit to His 12 disciples and the 70 unnamed people in Israel
- b. Have you received since you believed?
- 3. Evidences include prophesying, healing, and destroying the works of the devil.

Numbers 11:24-25, Acts 10:38, 1 John 3:8.

4. The mandate to believers is found in Mark 16.

Mark 16:15-18 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

- 5. The Holy Spirit is the One Who operates in the giftings through humans.
 - 1 Corinthians 12:4-6 Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord. And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all.
 - a. Jesus is the Chief Administrator of the kingdom of God and the kingdom of Heaven
 - b. The Father is the Chief of Operations (John 14:28)
- 6. There are 9 gifts of the Holy Spirit.
 - a. 3 represent the Father and His will: Word of Knowledge, Word of Wisdom, Discerning of Spirits
 - b. 3 represent the Son, Who is the Word, through speech, which is the spoken will of the Father: Prophecy, Tongues, Interpretation of Tongues
 - c. 3 represent the work of the Holy Spirit in the Earth: Faith, Healing, Miracles
- 7. Evidences of having the baptism with the Holy Spirit include the following:
 - a. The ability to cast out evil spirits and have them obey you
 - b. The Father releases the Holy Spirit to release one of the gifts to you to help others
 - c. A boldness of witness and a zeal to help others
 - d. The ability to lay hands on the sick and they shall recover
 - e. To do creative miracles in Jesus' name, and expecting the Father to come and do it by His Spirit.
 - f. Destroying the works of the devil.

Matthew 7:8-11 For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened. Or what man is there of you, whom if his son ask bread, will he give him a stone? Or if he ask a fish, will he give him a serpent? If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him?

Romans 11:29 For the gifts and calling of God are without repentance.

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- 8. What God has gifted you to do in the Earth is what you must do for the rest of your days.
 - Luke 9:62 And Jesus said unto him, No man, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God.
- 9. The gifts that have already been placed in you by the Holy Spirit can be stirred up again.
 - 1 Timothy 4:14 Neglect not the gift that is in thee, which was given thee by prophecy, with the laying on of the hands of the presbytery.
 - 2 Timothy 1:6 Wherefore I put thee in remembrance that thou stir up the gift of God, which is in thee by the putting on of my hands.

Walk Out

- 1. What is Walk Out?
 - a. Getting up and getting out of prison.
- 2. Why do we Walk Out?
 - a. Every believer will go to the judgment seat of Christ.
 - 2 Corinthians 5:10 For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad.
 - b. We want to be blessed for eternity. This is why we Walk Out!
- 3. To Walk Out well you need to really understand the difference between sanctification of your soul and your spirit.
 - a. Sanctification means to purify or purification.
 - 2 Corinthians 7:1 Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.
 - 1 Thessalonians 5:23 And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.
 - b. Soul includes mind, will and emotions.
 - c. Sanctification of spirit (removing a spirit) and sanctification of the soul (overcoming old programming of mind, will and emotions).
 - John 8:32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.
 - 1 John 4:18 There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.
 - Matthew 12:28 But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you.

- d. Put on the mind of Christ.
- 1 Corinthians 2:16 For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ.
- e. Having done all STAND!

Ephesians 6:13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

- 4. How to overcome in temptation.
 - a. You need to give the enemy trouble.
 - 2 Chronicles 16:9 For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in the behalf of them whose heart is perfect toward him. Herein thou hast done foolishly: therefore from henceforth thou shalt have wars.
 - b. Temptation will come

James 1:2-4 My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into divers temptations; knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience. But let patience have her perfect work that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing.

c. There is a blessing if you endure

James 1: 12-14 Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him. Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man: but every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own list, and enticed.

d. If you know you have a weak spot, study your notes and Word from the course guide.

Hebrews 2:1 therefore we ought to give the more earnest heed to the things which we have heard, lest at any time we should let them slip.

e. OH JOY!!!!!! Not, Oh, no.

Hebrews 2:18 For in that he himself suffered being tempted, he is able to succor them that are tempted.

- 5. What to do when healing and victory doesn't come as quickly as you had hoped?
 - a. Keep walking and set your jaw like flint! and decide to:
 - Keep your heart filled with the Word
 - Be thankful
 - Don't think, "I can't do this"
 - Don't be sluggish
 - Hold every thought captive
 - Stop living in the past
 - Guard your heart
 - b. Pouring over the Word prepares you to be ready for battle!

John 14:26 But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

Prayer of Repentance

Refer to the ministry list for each of the Discernment classes: Accusation, Bitterness, Occultism, Envy/Jealousy, Rejection, Unloving, and Fear. These are the basic, necessary elements of a prayer of repentance.

- Speak the prayer out loud; spirits cannot hear you think.
- It's not about your words, but the condition of your heart. Be gentle with yourself!
- Remember to forgive everyone against whom you've had an offense.
- Do not use guided visualization or ask Jesus to come into the original traumatic situation

Father God, I come to you in the name of Jesus.

I recognize and take responsibility in my life and in my generations for (accusation, bitterness, etc.).

I repent for and renounce participating with (spirit from the list).

I ask for forgiveness and I receive my forgiveness for serving ______. Thank you Father!

Prayer of Deliverance

In the name of Jesus I take authority over spirits of _______ (unforgiveness, resentment, retaliation, anger and wrath, violence and murder with the tongue...etc.), and I cast you out.

<u>Father's Love Prayer</u>

On behalf of a father that did not, could not, would not, or maybe just did not know how to tell you he loved you, I, your brother, will. I will take responsibility for your heart right now.

On behalf of your father, will you forgive him for not telling you he loved you? I am so sorry for the silence and for the junk that may have injured you and confused you and left you feeling stranded on the inside when you needed him so much.

In the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, I release you from this fear and confusion.

Now, you are going to hear these words for your heart:

I love you. I am so glad you were born. I am proud of you. You are a good son/daughter.

Parent's Repentance to Children

Parents sit down with or contact children and say something like this:

I love you and I want to tell you I've been looking at my life and my relationship with God. I know there are some places where I fell short as a parent. I want to say that I am so sorry for how that affected you.

Note: Do not ask them to forgive you. Do not give them details. Trust God to begin the restoration process.
